Canmore Base Tours

Three Sisters (25 min): Fly around Canmore's iconic Three Sisters Peaks, the Goat Mt. Range and Spray Lakes.

- W \$2 Green Initiative = Rack rate \$320.00/Guest + 5% GST + \$2 Green Initiative Donation = \$338. **Net Rate: \$272.00/guest + 5% GST + \$2 Green Initiative Donation = \$287.60.** THIS MEANS YOUR CLIENTS WILL BE DONATING TO ALPINE HELICOPTERS INC. GREEN INITIATIVE.*

Stoney Nakoda Base Tours

Warrior Lookout (20min): An action packed twenty minutes of flight in the mountains. See where the warrior looked over the spectacular river valley of Kananaskis.

- Children ages **0-6** fly free.
- Children **6-12** fly half price.
- Two person minimum flight booking.
- Solo passengers will be added to existing flight or pay for 1 additional seat.
- There are no other fees.

Tour Groups: Once the bookings are confirmed, we kindly ask the assigned Tour Directors to provide us with their tour groups information; Number of passengers, the flights they wish to go on, and names of guests (if possible at that time of contact.) Tour directors should contact us via email rather than phone. Tour Directors should confirm booking and numbers with us 48hrs prior to their flight time. In the event that the tour director does not confirm their booking with us we will cancel the booking and reopen that space for general sale.

Tour Directors should not then need to contact us on the day to confirm flights, we will contact them if we are unable to fly. However, if Tour Directors are coming for further afield (over 30 minutes from our base) we would recommend calling us before they leave their accommodation.

FITs: Where best possible please pass on any direct contact information for the independent travelers so we can reach out to them regarding anything that may affect their flight. If that is not possible we will contact your office to contact the client on the day of the flight. Guests do not need to contact us to confirm flight on the day of, we will contact you if we're unable to fly, however if guests are coming for further a field (over 30 minutes from our base) we would recommend calling us before they leave their accommodation.

Vouchers: One way that we can all "do our part" is to reduce our overall paper usage. Historically, we have had clients and tour directors bring us sheets of paper with confirmed numbers that we will then scan, store, and then present back to you for invoicing purposes. If you **DO** require your guests/tour directors to present us with a voucher for payment please sign here **Initial:**_____.

By not signing you agree that a reference number from yourselves for booking purposes will suffice as a method of payment via invoice.

Weather & Cancellation: Our pilots always make the final call with weather and cancellations. Where possible we make that call at least one hour before the flight time. This is not always guaranteed and being in the mountains means that weather can change pretty quickly. We reserve the right to cancel a tour at any point with regards to safety, weather and client satisfaction. If your group wishes to cancel please inform us as soon as possible.

Transport to and from our bases: We have very limited transport availability to and from our bases, you will need to contact us to arrange pickup and it may not be possible. From Banff we suggest guests using Roam Transport Route Number 3 to get between Banff and our Canmore Base.
