Guntû is less a yacht and more a floating ryokan. Tatami floors, hinoki wood, and floor-to-ceiling windows replace schedules and entertainment. Sailing through Japan's Seto Inland Sea, days are shaped by light, weather, and stillness.

Life on board is intentionally quiet. An experience rooted in presence, simplicity, and careful observation, where slowing down becomes the ultimate luxury.



Routes through the Seto Inland Sea, gliding past small islands, fishing villages, and quiet coastal landscapes between Honshu, Shikoku, and Kyushu.

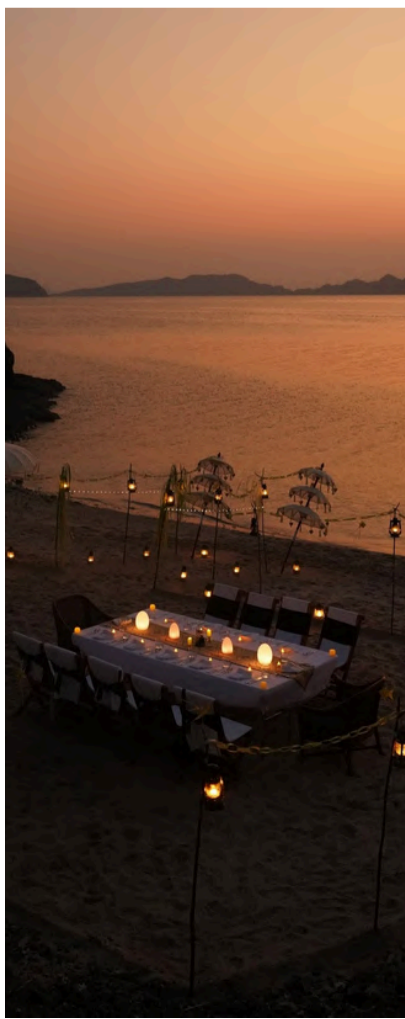

Life on board follows Aman's unmistakable rhythm: quiet mornings, open decks, and landscapes that reveal themselves slowly. Amandira sails Komodo with just five cabins, feeling closer to a private charter than a cruise.

Amangati, launching in 2027, extends this same sense of serenity into the wider Indian Ocean. Both experiences are defined by space, discretion, and an unhurried way of moving through water and place.

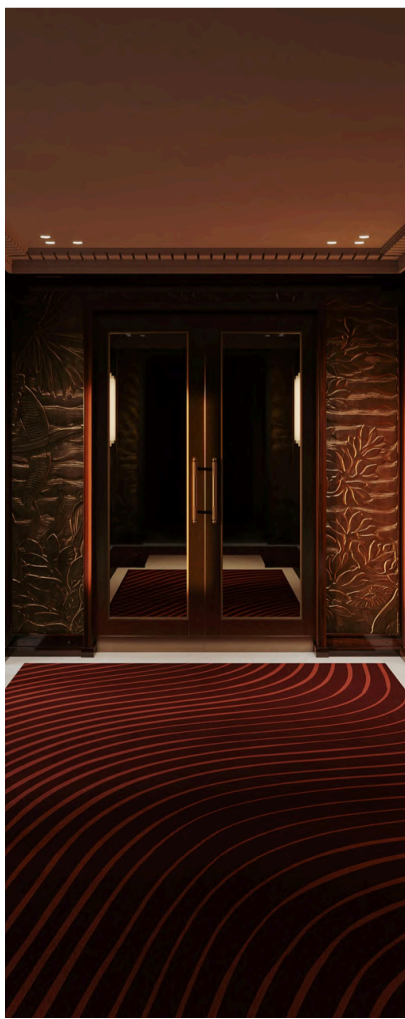

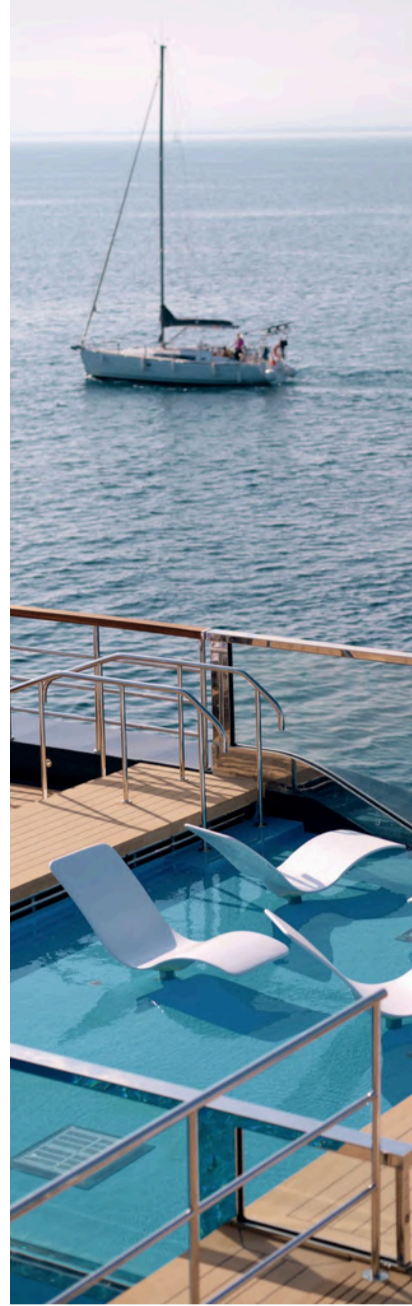
