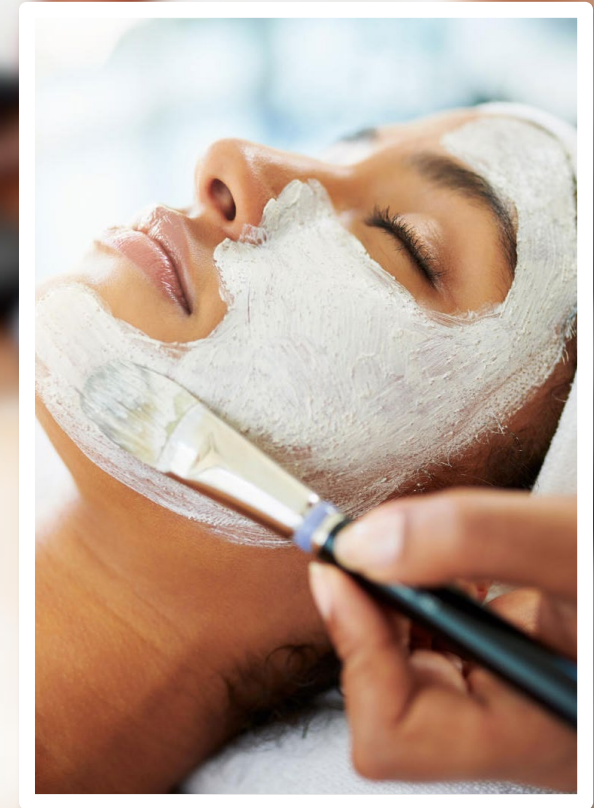
THERAPIES & RITUALS

Glacier Contrast Therapy Ritual: guided hot-cold ritual inspired by Alaska's glaciers and Nordic sauna traditions programmed at the Marina. To leverage a portable sauna infused with spruce, cedar, and juniper; Marina Beach cold plunge pool; and finish with warmed robes and herbal elixirs

Glacier Mud Therapies: detoxifying face masks and/or body wraps using mineral-rich glacier mud and antioxidant-packed green tea to draw out impurities and soothe skin

SCRUB

Wild Alaskan Botanical Body Scrub: scrub incorporating local botanicals like fireweed, birch, and berries

ONBOARD ACTIVITIES

Wildlife Watching: Guests will have the opportunity to learn about the wildlife in Alaska and surrounding waters and, with luck, spot them from the deck. Onboard team will be equipped with the knowledge of types of wildlife in the area, along with binoculars and printed handouts to enrich the experience.

Salt Blending: This activity will highlight the flavors of Alaska, allowing guests to create custom salt blends that reflect the destinations natural elements.

Trivia: We will offer unique trivia sessions where guests can learn more about the local culture, wildlife, and customs while being onboard, providing a fun way to connect without leaving the ship.

THE MARINA

GOLF

Guests can hit biodegradable golf balls off the Marina at floating targets within the water (port permission dependent) or into a netted cage. Two mats will be stationed on the hydromar with both men's and women's clubs available. Guests will be provided a bucket of balls to hit at their leisure. Signature beverages round out the experience. A netted option for a self contained golf experience is available for activations in environmentally sensitive areas.

COLD PLUNGE (NEW)

Offering guests two ways to plunge – a netted plunge tub that is submerged into the Alaskan waters or by jumping in directly and secured with a tethered belt. Exploring portable saunas to deliver a contrast therapy experience, with an opportunity to engage a cold plunge expert for select voyages. Finish with warmed robes and herbal elixirs.

PICKLEBALL

Guests can jump into a game of pickleball at the ship's bow. The AquaBana inflatable sport court prototype is currently in its trial phase aboard Ilma. Early findings indicate opportunities to refine the inflatable sport court design, optimizing for form and function, in time for Luminara's Alaska season.

ZODIAC EXCURSIONS

Small-group Zodiac outings led by naturalist drivers, offering a close-up exploration of fjords, glaciers, and wildlife for an additional fee. Zodiac boats will be RCYC branded and guests will be provided light protective gear (waterproof pants, rain apparel).

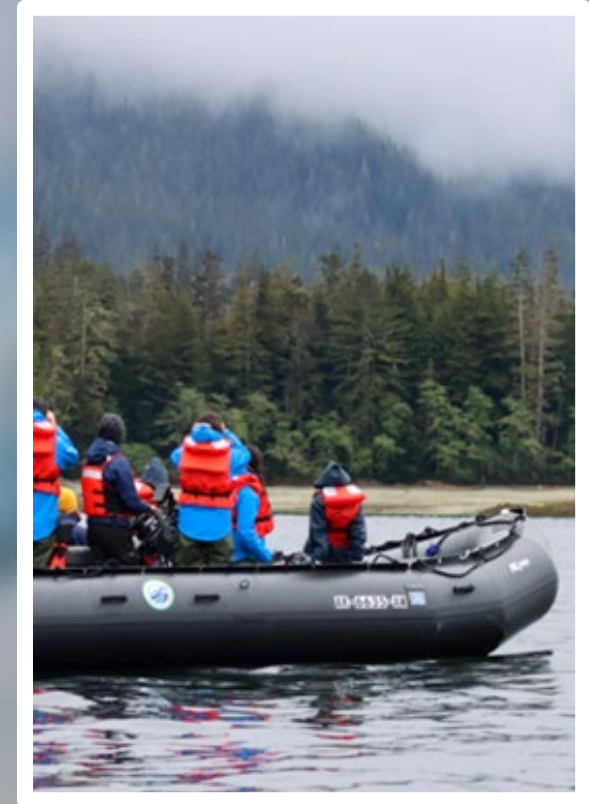
